Annual Report SCTG, Amsterdam, 2016

Good News

We are happy that Yangsi Trogawa Rinpoche is enthusiastically and diligently continuing his studies in the Choten Gonpa in Gangthok and we hope that Ven Kyabje Dodrubchen Rinpoche may live long, so that he will be able to guide Yangsi Trogawa Rinpoche in these studies.

We are also delighted with the decision of the Board to shift the College classrooms, library, museum and offices as soon as possible to a part of the first floor of the Pharmacy building in Salugara.

The sale of the compound in Takdah provides new opportunities for raising seed-money to start the construction of the College complex in Salugara.

Sponsor activities

An amount of **35,000.-** euro was still needed to finish the first floor of the Pharmacy construction.

In 2016 the SCTG received a total of **3,395.-** euro for the Pharmacy construction and **1,640.-** for general projects. The Chagpori donation box collected **3,460.-** euro. Together this **8,495.-** euro helped towards the total of **35,000.-** euro.

During the visit of Trinley-la this Autumn, the B.A. Foundation promised to donate another **6,000.-** euro for the windows of the 1st floor, (which we received in the beginning of 2017.)

All together the amount of **35,000.-euro** was reached through the help of the Chagpori SGs of Germany, France and Holland!

To solve the problems with the poor electrical power for the big pharmacy machines, in 2016 the B.A. Foundation sponsored **6,000.-** for a transformer.

The sponsoring of the students in 2016 was **7,965.-** euro.

We still have a sponsorship of **750.-** euro for the salary of some of the doctors.

The Yangchen Drolma Fund donated **12,000.-** euro as additional compensation for the staff salary. This sponsorship will be reduced by 25% from Losar 2017 onwards.

This year we received **1,416.-** euro in donations for our Yangsi Rinpoche.

The bank interest was **189.-** euro.

So altogether we have raised **36,814.-** euro and in total we have sent **40,060.-** euro to CTMI (there was a remnant in the bank account on 31-12-'15).

Activities in Holland

We are happy that we found some new sponsors for the students, and at the same time there are still some students without a sponsor.

It was so good that the director, president Amchi Trinley Trogawa, and also earlier in the year the general secretary Tsering Norbhu Dekeva, could come to Holland and meet with the SCTG board. They had a meeting with Paul Tameling, board-member

of the B.A. Foundation and with Bert Kuipers, webmaster/ designer for the CTMI, Darjeeling, the SCTG as well as the Chagpori Clinic Amsterdam.

It is essential to keep the connection with CTMI alive here in the West. Nel de Jong visited Chagpori this year in December and was impressed by the outcome of the Pharmacy building as well as the ongoing activities of pill making and the new Chagpori products.

Most of these products are available in the Chagpori Clinic in Amsterdam.

The last year we strongly suggested that the different European SGs should meet regularly to be able to inspire and strengthen the support activities.

We hope to realize this in 2017.
