In the year 2023 none of the Board members of the SCTG was able to visit the Institute in Darjeeling.

However, we stayed in close contact via the director Amchi Trinley Trogawa and through him we received the necessary information.

The 14 students are doing well and their progress is very promising.

From Holland we could support the majority of the students via the donations made by our sponsors. We thank them very much for their continued support.

Our Yangsi Trogawa Rinpoche is studying in the monastery of the late Venerable Dodrubchen Rinpoche and he expressed the wish to take the preliminary vows to become a monk. He has taken these vows during this past year. As of now, he is mainly focused on the study of Buddhism and not yet on the study of Tibetan medicine.

The Support Group was able to also find some sponsors for the maintenance, renovation and construction of the property in Takdah/ Salugara and Darjeeling.

The Institute is still working on the requirements set by the Ayush, which takes lots of administrational work.

Actually, the Institute needs a general manager besides the medical director and more office staff is urgently needed. The request for help in this regard been given to the government in exile in Dharamsala. Let's hope this will work out soon.
